- Mayor Sayeau: Health Unit has gone strictly to a 1-800 number, and the province has a number as well. With the HU number, you will get an appointment in our area. All vaccinations require appointments. Some pharmacies take walk-ins, or have their own booking system. Final tax bills will be in the mail.
- Darren – have provided \$2,000,000 in funding for 40+ businesses. Same opportunities for counselling are available.
